Patrick and I have had a number of discussions over the last two days with Brad Wiblin from BRIDGE and Jim Palmer from the Temecula-Murrieta Rescue Mission. Jim stated that he and Scott will attend the workshop tonight and Jim will announce "up front" that the Rescue Mission will withdraw its proposal for Supportive Affordable Housing at the Summerhouse site but will be working with the City to evaluate alternative options. It is my understanding that Scott will also make a statement. Then, both Jim and Scott will answer questions from the audience. Once they conclude with the question and answer session, it is my intention to read the statement below. Please let me know if you have any concerns or questions (and in conformance with the Brown Act, please do not copy "All Council Members" on your response). Thank you for your assistance.

"As a result of the Rescue Mission's request for withdrawal of their application at Summerhouse, and input we have received from the community, BRIDGE Housing will be developing alternative uses for the Rescue Mission site including "senior" affordable housing, "moderate income" housing and/or "for sale" affordable housing. BRIDGE Housing will also be seeking input from interested members of the community concerning alternatives for the Rescue Mission site.

City staff and BRIDGE Housing will be holding a joint public workshop on September 10, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Recreation Center (CRC) to discuss proposed alternative land uses, to answer questions and to listen to comments from the public.

The public hearing before City Council regarding proposed development at Summerhouse has been rescheduled from September 8<sup>th</sup> to September 22, 2009."
